Nicholas Bell and Roger Lane-Smith, being the independent directors for the purpose of the purchase, having consulted with Shore Capital, the Company's Nominated Adviser, consider the terms of the Purchase to be fair and reasonable insofar as the Company's shareholders are concerned. None of the directors of the Company are beneficially interested in the Scheme.

The Company's issued share capital now comprises 17,151,025 Ordinary Shares (excluding Ordinary Shares held in treasury). The total current voting rights in the Company is therefore 17,151,025.

The above figure (17,151,025 Ordinary Shares) is the figure which may be used by shareholders as the denominator for the calculation by which they will determine if they are required to notify their interest in, or a change to their interest in, the Company.
